#### In the Beginning...

On April 12, 1871, residents of Indianola petitioned to bring a railroad from the Town of Victoria to a point on the east side of the Guadalupe River at a distance no greater than 3 miles from Clinton Ferry to be called Cuero. By December of 1871, The Cuero Land & Immigration Company was formed and Cuero was born. The City of Cuero was officially chartered by the State of Texas on April 23, 1873 when the Home Rule Charter was adopted. Growth and prosperity abounded in this newly created town. In just 3 short years, Cuero became the county seat, which in prior years had flip flopped between Cameron and Clinton.
